PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Shalom, y'all, and Shalom, Spring!

Our small Mountain Synagogue community has been busy, and I believe, feeling very connected. Connected for those that have joined us in worship and fellowship, and hopefully, via Zoom.

We had a wonderful Passover Seder, led by Yosi Knight, followed by an interesting Shabbat service the following Saturday morning. All that attended found it meaningful and though provoking.

In preparing for our upcoming Board meeting, I read a D'var Torah by Cantor David Fair on Reimagining Reform Kashrut and other Jewish laws. In other words, how we interpret some, and not others in quite the same way. As a small congregation here in the mountains, people ask us from time to time to explain about the different denominations within Judaism, and how we interpret the laws of the bible. For example, "Do Refom jews keep kosher?"

We know the Torah is a historical document, and we base our lives on the values, messages and stories outlined in our sacred history, but we don't use it as a how-to guide for every day. Laws that worked thousands of years ago don't always apply to the modern world. We have to be able to say "This law, in its literal form, does not apply to our modern lives. This other law does." We learn to adapt.

So, we have to learn to discern "What is God trying to tell us here?" The concept of interpreting God's law is nothing new. The Talmud is full of stories of the Rabbi's arguing over every law in the Torah. It's part of what makes Judaism so unique as a religion.

So, as we, as a congregation interpret and evolve, we learn and hopefully grow, together. So it is that our Shabbat schedule will continue to be once a month on the third Saturday of the month, unless we need to adapt.

I pray we continue to connect and enjoy the times we do come together, both at worship services as well as our social gathering at dinners and other community events.
